 - Org & Est Plan approval
 - Still a transition period



- The Order of St-Georges Medal for Cadets
 - To honour Staff Cadets who distinguish themselves in their exemplary contribution at a CTC or at a Junior Canadian Ranger Enhanced Training Session (ETS)
 - Criteria and selection process are being developed
 - Planning for first award this summer 2016



Current initiatives - General

Op Provision

- No further requirement for use of CTC facilities
- Some of our CTC infrastructure was winterized

Op Distinction

- Several celebratory / anniversaries coming up
- Vimy Centennial Celebrations:
 - VAC and CJOC restrictions, (possibly CDS approval & no-uniform)
 - Limited space during week of 9 Apr 17
 - Deadline for approval to Natl CJCR Sp Gp HQ was 1 June 16;
 - EF Educational Tours cooperating closely with Natl CJCR Sp Gp;
 - Currently examining the requests for approval

Current Initiatives for Air Cadet Flying Program

- Air Cadet Gliding Program
 - Atlantic Region pause lifted (only small exceptions remaining)
- Power Pilot Scholarship Program
 - 245 Cadets to be trained this year
 - Examination of a raise to the funding cap set by Treasury Board
- Air Cadet Fleet
 - Aging fleet
 - Fleet renewal being examined
 - Fleet deployment and standardization

Current Initiatives for Sea/Army/Air Cadets – Training

- National Biathlon Championship 2016, Valcartier, QC
 - 2 to 7 March 16
 - The updated format offered more cadet leadership opportunities
 - Allowed for more flexibility at the cadet corps level
- National Marksmanship Championship 2016, Gimli, MB
 - 2 to 7 May 16
 - New this year was a two-prong selection provincial: provincial and national
 - Lessons learned being captured








RCSU Structure and Support to Corps / Sqn




Corps / Sqn Support Network
