

CONTINUATION FLYING TRAINING AWARDS APPLICATION INFORMATION

The purpose of the Continuation Flying Training Awards offered by our partners listed below is to provide cadets who have successfully completed the Power Pilot Scholarship Course the opportunity to continue to accumulate pilot-incommand flight time. The awards range in value from \$1000 to \$2500.

Awards will be given to the highest achievers as determined by the Chief Flying Instructor at the assigned flight school. Awards will be allocated proportionately across all regions.

Cadets must meet all of the following conditions of eligibility:

- a) Must complete the Continuation Flying Training Awards Application Form and supporting paragraph and submit it to the Chief Flying Instructor a minimum of one week prior to Graduation Parade;
- b) Must have successfully completed the Power Pilot Scholarship Course;
- c) Must hold a current Transport Canada Private Pilot License;
- d) Must be recommended by the Flight School Chief Flying Instructor;
- e) Must be a member of record of a squadron at the time of graduation from the course;
- f) Must demonstrate an interest in continuation flying; and
- g) Must indicate a strong interest in a possible career in any aspect of aviation.

With the exception of the Civil Air Search and Rescue (CASARA) Award, final selection of award recipients will be made by the Chair of the National Aviation Committee or designated National representative of the National Aviation Committee. Funds will be distributed, in the cadet's name, to the flight school where the cadet will complete their flying time. If the graduate is proceeding to college or university, the funds will be forwarded to the Registrar's Office of the institution named in the application to be credited toward the recipient's tuition. Although CASARA will select the recipient of their award, funds will be distributed by the Air Cadet League.

Award recipients will be announced at the Semi-Annual Meeting of the Air Cadet League in **November** each year.
