2.6 COPA Fund Raising Mailing

A last-minute direction from COPA indicated that the cost of inserting the four League items was not \$1000 total as originally advised but \$100 per 1000 per piece (distribution of 18,000 for a total cost of \$7200). To save \$5400, ACLHQ staff collated and stapled all 18,000 packages, then considered one item. This required four days of uninterrupted office time and considerable overtime during the Thanksgiving weekend to complete by the deadline.

3.1 National Fund Raising Strategic Plan – Prospect Search

A phase approach to researching prospective donors has been proposed. Support for this approach, including funding, is sought.

- Phase I: Introductory (5 hours)
- Phase II: Research Phase (120 hours)
- Phase III: Review (10 hours)
- Total Hours: 135 hours
- Hourly Wage: \$15/hr
- Estimated Cost: Approximately \$2000
- Phase IV Preparing the Request for Funding (Approximately 2-3 weeks. Not costed)

Discussion centred on the potential overlap with PC fundraising donor lists. C. Hawkins noted that before prospects would be approached, coordination with each PC must occur to avoid duplication of requests.
