

# The Air Cadet League of Canada is pleased to offer Flying Training Awards.

## **Continuation Flying Training Awards (CFTA):**

The purpose of the Continuation Flying Training Awards offered by our partners listed below is to provide cadets who have successfully completed the Power Pilot Scholarship Course the opportunity to continue to accumulate flight time. The awards are from \$1000 to \$2500 each.

## **Pilot Training Achievement Awards (PTAA):**

The purpose of the Pilot Training Achievement Awards is to provide funding for use in continuing a cadet's flying or gliding training. The awards average \$300 in value.

Awards will be given to the highest achievers on Transport Canada assessments combined with outstanding performance as an Air Cadet. Power scholarship graduates may apply to both the CFTA and the PTAA. Awards will be allocated proportionately across all regions. Only one Flying Award will be granted to a cadet in any given year.

### **Cadets must meet all of the following conditions of eligibility:**

- a) Must complete the Flying Training Awards Application Form.
- b) A statement of approximately 300 words outlining your career goals and objectives. Explain why you are interested in pursuing your flying and/or a possible career in aviation.
- c) Must have successfully completed the Power Pilot Scholarship Course for the CFTA;
- d) Must have successfully completed the Glider Scholarship Course or the Power Pilot Scholarship Course for the PTAA;
- e) Must hold a current Transport Canada Private Pilot Licence or Glider Pilot Licence;
- f) Must be recommended by their flight instructor or RCA Ops O, their squadron Commanding Officer and Sponsoring Committee Chair.

Applications and supporting documents for all Flying Training Awards must be received in digital form, (one PDF file), **no later than Sept. 30, 2019** at the National Office of the Air Cadet League of Canada, [leaguehq@aircadetleague.com](mailto:leaguehq@aircadetleague.com). The email should be titled beginning with Flying Training Awards followed by your name such as: *Flying Training Awards\_ JONES\_Fred*.

The National Air Cadet Scholarships and Awards Committee, comprised of members of the National Advisory Council, will consider all eligible candidates. The Chairperson of the Committee will declare the name of the recipients. Decisions of the committee will be considered final.

Award recipients will be announced at the Semi-Annual Meeting of the Air Cadet League in November. Following the announcement, the recipient will be requested to provide a photograph

or digital image (in uniform) for purposes of publicity. The recipient also agrees to allow their application to be shared with the scholarship sponsor.

Funds for the Continuation Flying Awards will be distributed, in the cadet's name, to the flight school where the cadet will complete their flying time. Funds must be used by October 31, 2020. The Pilot Training Achievement Awards winners will be presented with a cheque at an appropriate time determined by the Chair of the Provincial Air Cadet League and the Squadron Sponsoring Committee Chair.
