

THE AIR CADET LEAGUE OF CANADA MEMBER LONG SERVICE MEDAL APPLICATION FORM: ACC63

The Air Cadet League of Canada's Member Long Service Medal is awarded to an individual in recognition of ten years of volunteer service to the Air Cadet League. This service can be at any level: Local (Squadron Sponsoring Committee), Provincial or National or any combination of service at different levels. The 10 years of Volunteer Service does not have to be consecutive or with the same Squadron / Provincial Committee.

The application is submitted to the Provincial Committee in the jurisdiction where the individual currently resides. The Chair of the Provincial Committee's Honours and Awards Committee will be the approving authority and will make arrangements for the medal to be delivered / presented to the individual at an appropriate occasion. The Chair of the National Honours and Awards Committee will act as the approving authority and will make arrangements for the medal to be delivered / presented to individuals who only volunteer at the National level.
