OTTAWA, ON (July 20, 2020) - The Air Cadet League of Canada (ACL) congratulates **Warrant Officer Second Class (WO2) Chloe Yip** who has been awarded the new \$2,500.00 CAE Post-Secondary Scholarship.

WO2 Yip is from 111 Vancouver Pegasus, Royal Canadian Air Cadet Squadron. While maintaining a very good academic record, WO2 Yip completed the Glider Pilot and Power Pilot Scholarships course, as well as the Air Rifle Marksmanship Instructor course. She is the head ground school instructor at her squadron and aims to work toward her Commercial Pilot Licence to eventually become a flying instructor. In recognition of her tremendous efforts, WO2 Yip has won the Duke of Edinburgh Award and the Lord Strathcona Medal. WO2 Yip has applied to the University of British Columbia to pursue a degree in Arts.
