While maintaining an excellent academic record, WO1 Kim completed the Glider Pilot and Power Pilot Scholarships courses, multiple hours as a ground school assistant instructor, and he is an executive member of the OSA Chess Club. In recognition of his tremendous efforts, WO1 Kim has won the Duke of Edinburgh Award and the Royal Canadian Legion Cadet Medal of Excellence. WO1 Kim has applied to the University of Alberta to pursue a career in medicine.
