## 2020 CAE Post-Secondary Scholarship Recipient\* [SEP]

OTTAWA, ON (July 20, 2020) - The Air Cadet League of Canada (ACL) congratulates **Warrant Officer Second Class (WO2) MacKenzie Rose Guillou-Cormier** who has been awarded \$2,500, one of the CAE Post-Secondary Scholarship.

WO2 Guillou-Cormier is from 176 Boeing, Royal Canadian Air Cadet Squadron. While maintaining a very good academic record, WO2 Guillou-Cormier is a musically accomplished cadet, as she had dedicated multiple hours to various band activities and has spent numerous hours as President and Camp Counsellor. In recognition of her tremendous efforts, WO2 Guillou-Cormier has won the Duke of Edinburgh Award, the Royal Canadian Legion Cadet Medal of Excellence, and the ANAVETS Cadet Medal of Merit. WO2 Guillou-Cormier has applied to the University of Manitoba to pursue a degree in Music Education.
