	Qualitative Measures of Likelihood
Likelihood Level	Definition
5 - Almost Certain	Expected to occur in most circumstances
4 – Likely	Will probably occur in most circumstances
3 – Possible	Could occur at some time
2 – Unlikely	Not expected to occur
1 – Rare	Occurs only in exceptional circumstances

	Qualitative Measures of Impact (Threat)
Impact Level	Definition
5 – Severe	Would stop the achievement of functional goals or objectives.
4 – Major	Would threaten the achievement of functional goals or
3 – Moderate	Necessitates significant adjustment to overall functions.
2 – Minor	Would threaten an element of goals or objectives.
1 – Insignificant	Lower consequences

Directions: Ask the initial questions in each category. What is the Likelihood of 1-3 / and if it Does Happen, what is the Impact? Determine risk impact score. (Likelihood x impact). Risk Score 15 - 25 = $\frac{\text{Very High}}{\text{Very High}}$, 8 - 14 = $\frac{\text{High}}{\text{High}}$. 4 - 8 = $\frac{\text{Medium}}{\text{Medium}}$, and 1 - 3 = $\frac{\text{Low}}{\text{Low}}$ Tackle highest numbers first, then follow through as applicable. Capture and add any other category that is relevant to your Squadron/SSC.
