## Annual Music Awards for Excellence for Air Cadets

In order to promote music in the Air Cadet Movement, the Air Cadet League of Canada has established annual awards for outstanding Air Cadet Musicians. This years, two cash awards of \$350 sponsored by Long & McQuade and a watch offered by the RCAFA and the ACL are presented, one each to an outstanding:



- (a) Air Cadet Pipe Band Musician
- (b) Air Cadet Military Band Musician.

The Music Awards are open to members of the Royal Canadian Air Cadets during the year of application, and they are awarded based on music abilities combined with outstanding performance as an Air Cadet.

Cadets must meet all of the following conditions of eligibility:

- a) Must complete the Music Awards Application Form ACC-58;
- b) Must have completed a minimum of two years of continuous service as a member of an Air Cadet Pipe Band or Military Band by the date of nomination;
- c) Must provide a statement of approximately 300 words outlining your career goals and objectives;
- d) Must provide video of the level four or five test;
- e) Must have an outstanding performance as an Air Cadet.

The applicant is required to submit a video recording of the two approved pieces of music that he/she performed to achieve music level four or five. It is requested that a uniformed officer appear with the uniformed cadet at the beginning of the recording to verbally authenticate the identity of the cadet. The cadet must be visible throughout the entire video recording.

Applications and supporting documents for all Music Awards for Excellence must be received in digital form, (one PDF file), **no later than October 30, 2020** at the National Office of the Air Cadet League of Canada, leaguehq@aircadetleague.com. The email should be titled beginning with Music Awards followed by your name such as: *Music Awards\_JONES\_Fred*.

The National Cadet Scholarships and Awards Committee, in collaboration with the National Music Committee, will consider all eligible candidates. The Chairperson of the Committee will declare the name of the recipient of the Music Awards at the latest on December 1<sup>st</sup>.


