The Air Cadet League of Canada Announces 2022 Flying Scholarships Recipients

OTTAWA, ON (December 21, 2022) – The Air Cadet League of Canada is pleased to announce the names of the 31 recipients of the 2022 Flight Training Achievement Awards. Thanks to the generosity of our partners and donors. We can present 14 Pilot Training Achievement Awards (PTAA) and 17 Continuation Flying Training Awards (CFTA)

PTAA: The purpose of the Pilot Training Achievement Awards is to provide funding for use in continuing a cadet's flying or gliding training. The awards average \$300 in value.

CFTA: The purpose of the Continuation Flying Training Awards offered by our partners is to provide cadets who have successfully completed the Power Pilot Scholarship Course the opportunity to continue to accumulate flight time. The awards are from \$1000 to \$2500 each. It is hoped that these qualified recipients will one day give back to the program by becoming future flight instructors.
