The Air Cadet League of Canada Announces 2022 Flight Completion Training Award's Recipients

OTTAWA, ON (February 13, 2023) – The Air Cadet League of Canada is pleased to announce that 16 cadets have been qualified for the temporary Flight Training Achievement Awards.

The purpose of the Flying Training Completion Award (FTCA) is to provide cadets who, due to circumstances beyond their control, were “incomplete” on the CJCR Power Pilot or Glider Pilot Course in 2022 but went on to obtain a Transport Canada license on their own. Seven awards of \$1000 for power pilots and nine awards of \$500 for glider pilots are being awarded.
